This notice is to inform you that beginning in late May 2010 work on the replacement of the Clayton Road Bridge over Deer Creek (under I-64) will start. The existing bridge is 78 years old and is in a deteriorated condition. Construction will begin with a pedestrian bridge that will separate vehicle traffic from the pedestrians.

In an effort to maintain vehicle traffic in the area and access to the business district, the bridge will be demolished and rebuilt in two stages. During this time traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction. We have included a financial incentive in the contract for early completion of the project. We anticipate project completion by late September or early October of this year.

It is recommended that when possible alternate routes should be used to avoid the construction area. Other east-west alternate roads include Litzsinger Road and Manchester Road to the South, and Ladue Road and Olive Blvd.
