

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**STORM WATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Notice is hereby given that the Storm Water Advisory Committee, the Committee of the City of Ladue, St. Louis County, Missouri, will hold a public hearing to determine if the Deerfield-Wakefield Stormwater Infrastructure Improvements project will be placed on inactive status. City of Ladue Ordinance No. 2137, Sec. 2-326(B) states, "In the event that the progress of a project becomes stalled during the design stage due to a failure to reach an agreement/solution with the impacted parties, and it is so deemed by the committee, a project may be recommended to be placed on inactive status. Prior to this designation, a hearing shall be held at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Committee."

The hearing will be held at 8:00 A.M. on Thursday, April 6, 2023, at the Ladue City Hall, 9345 Clayton Road.

The hearing will be open to the public. Anyone interested in the proceedings will be given the opportunity to be heard.
