**Docket 1392** Petition submitted by Felix and Malissa Ungacta for the property located at 38 Deerfield Terrace. The petitioner is requesting relief from the storm water engineer denying a landscape berm which appears to cause an increase in the water surface elevation because it reduces the available storage for sinkhole flooding. This is in violation of Ladue Ordinance 2250. **Continued to 10-3-23**

**Docket 1394** Appeal petition submitted by Paul Martin Law, L.L.C., representing David P. Oetting, regarding the issuance of a building permit for construction of a new home at 4 Glenview Road. Petitioner contends that the property is in violation of III.A(3)(b) and V.B.(1) of the Zoning Ordinance due to the lot not meeting the minimum 90' frontage requirement for the C zoning district and that construction approval should not have been granted.

**Docket 1395** Petition submitted by Thomas and Carolyn Vandiver for the property at 849 Kent Road. Petitioners are requesting relief from the City Planner denying the placement of a generator within the 50-foot side yard setback in the B residential district. Proposed generator is in violation of Sections IV.J.(1) and V.B.(1) of the Ladue Zoning Ordinance (#1175).
