Approval of the agenda: Council Member Howell moved approval of the agenda, upon second by Council Member Burroughs the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Consideration:

Face-covering mandate for unvaccinated employees.

At the September 27th, 2021, City Council meeting Council voted unanimously to enact a face-covering requirement for all unvaccinated employees upon guidance of the CDC and the St. Louis County Department of Health. The face-covering requirement is in place until rescinded by a vote of the Council.

Mayor Spewak stated that on March 6, 2022, the St. Louis County mask mandate expired and the St. Louis County Department of Health, acknowledging the decrease in risk has announced that the face covering order will no longer be in effect.


Fire Chief Lynn stated that the community transmission rate continues to decrease
