ORDINANCE NO. 2208

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF TAXES TO BE LEVIED AND COLLECTED TO SUPPORT THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Ninety-First General Assembly enacted House Bill 1327 requiring all political subdivisions to revise their applicable tax rates of levy for each subclass of real property, individually, and for personal property, in the aggregate; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ladue has determined the appropriate tax rates, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ladue has held a duly-noticed public hearing on the topic on September 26, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LADUE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following tax rates are levied in compliance with and pursuant to Section 137.073, Revised Statutes of Missouri:

Residential	\$ 0.6760
Commercial	\$ 0.6530
Agricultural	\$ 0.0000
Personal	\$ 0.7560

per \$100.00 of assessed valuation of all subjects of objects of taxation and all property within the City of Ladue, real or personal, as applicable, made taxable by law as such appears on the tax books; the purpose of such tax being to support the operating budget for the fiscal period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

If the tax rate ceiling allowed is less than or greater than the proposed rate, the City of Ladue will set the final rate as determined by the St. Louis County Board of Equalization final assessed values and as validated by the State of Missouri Auditor.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
