

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF ELECTION AND
CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD
CITY OF LADUE
ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI**

In accordance with the Revised Statutes of Missouri and ordinances of the City of Ladue, notice is given that a General Municipal Election shall be held in the City of Ladue, St. Louis County, Missouri, on Tuesday April 2, 2019. At said election, there shall be elected one Mayor and one Council Member each from Wards One, Two and Three of the City for two-year terms; and other such matters as may be lawfully placed upon the ballot shall be voted upon.

Qualifications for Office of Mayor (RSMo Section 79.080)

79.080. No person shall be mayor unless he is at least twenty-five years of age, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city at the time of and for at least one year next preceding his election; and such other qualifications as prescribed by law.

Qualifications for Office of Alderman (Council Member) (RSMo Section 79.070)

79.070. No person shall be an alderman unless he or she is at least eighteen years of age, a citizen of the United States, and an inhabitant and resident of the city for one year next preceding his or her election, and a resident, at the time he or she files and during the time he or she serves, of the ward from which he or she is elected; and such other qualifications as prescribed by law.

Filing for office as Mayor or Alderman (Council Member) opens at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 2018, and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, 2019. Each person filing for election as Mayor or as Council Member must file a declaration of candidacy and such other forms as prescribed by law. Declaration of Candidacy forms may be filed from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, (excluding holidays and such other times when City Hall is officially closed) with the City Clerk or her designee at Ladue City Hall, 9345 Clayton Road.

Declarations of candidacy may be withdrawn only prior to five (5:00) p.m. on Tuesday January 15, 2019, unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Election Commissioners or a court of competent jurisdiction. (115.125 RSMO.)
