



Warson Road Project Continues Ahead of Schedule

Missouri American Water Crews continue to be ahead of schedule on the Warson Road water main replacement project. Crews will begin on Phase 4 on May 10. As an overview, approximately 4,500 feet of water main dating back to the 1920's and 40's will be replaced at the project's completion.

Replacing these old mains, looping existing water mains and adding new valves will significantly reduce the number of water main breaks.

To date the following phases are **complete**:

Phase 1: Replacement of pipe along Warson Road to Carters Grove Court to Old Warson Road

Phase 2: Replacement of pipe at the intersection of Warson Road and Old Warson Road

Phase 3: Replacement of pipe along Old Warson Road from Warson Road to just before the eastern connection of Waterbury Drive.

Crews will begin on Phase 4 May 10 working on Old Warson Road from eastern Waterbury Drive to Des. Peres Avenue. Once all pipe is installed, crews then pressure test the pipe, sample for water quality and connect services. Street repaving and property restoration will begin upon completion of the project which is now early fall.
